ANIMATION RESEARCH

Animation research is a combined course and has been planned to integrate with the studio practice course No. GTA6160.

This course is intended to provide a student with visual research useful to an animator. The information gleaned in the museum will be applied as ideation and finished artwork in the studio practice course.

Weekly visits to the Royal Ontario Museum will allow systematic research projects to be undertaken. Galleries have been booked for 6 main subject headings. The galleries are listed below.

The museum provides drawing stools, which if used, must be replaced at the conclusion of each visit. Students will be encouraged to pursue their own research within the parameters of the assignments. All assignments must be executed according to the brief. In-studio critiques will provide assessment of the artwork and research material.
