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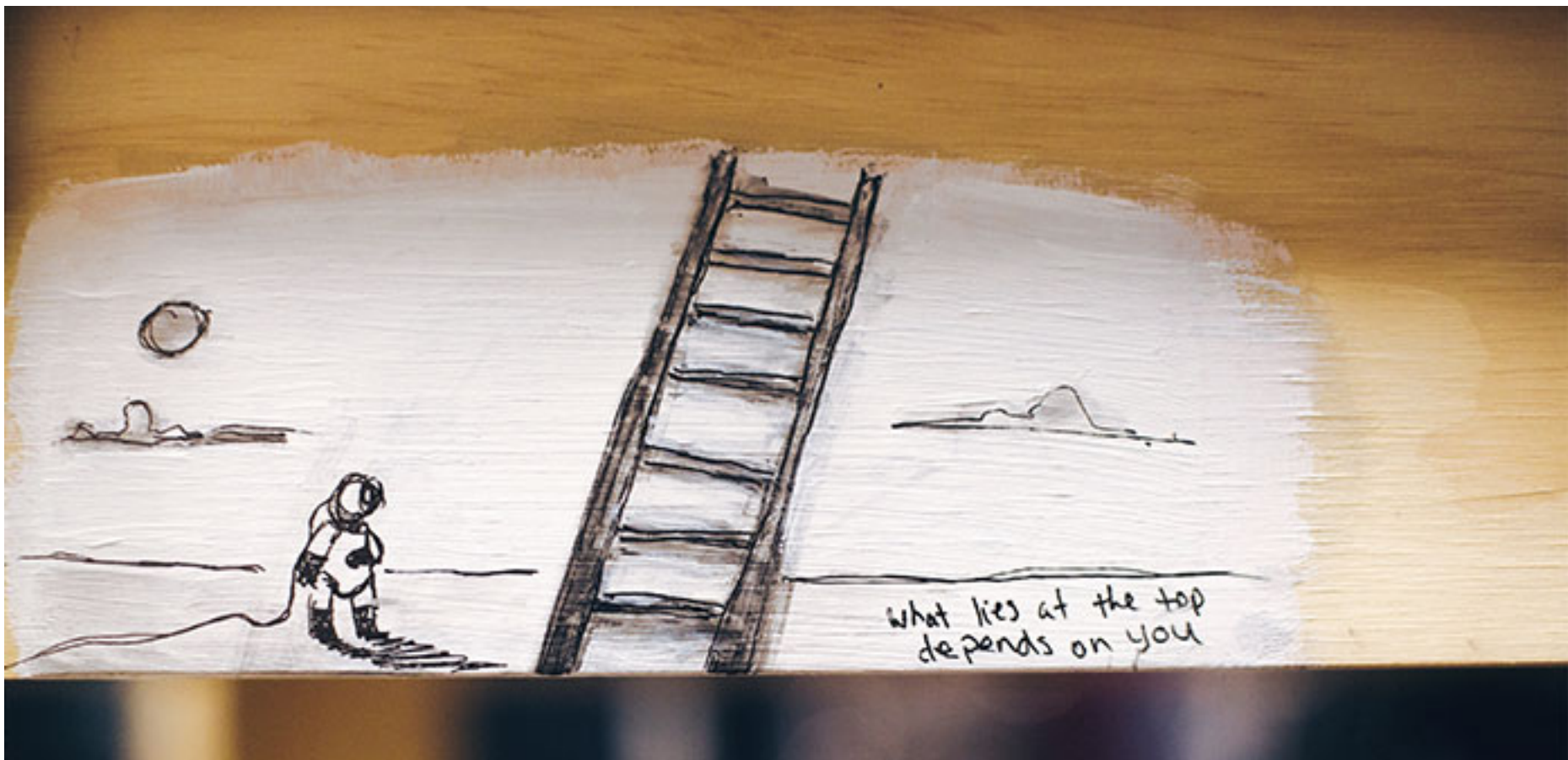

What's working?



1. IL PRESENCE

- Communications Course IL integration
 - Increased uptake
 - Positive feedback
 - Librarians and technicians trained to deliver
- Strong FY instruction stats
 - ~60% of all library workshops are for FY courses



2. PARTNERSHIPS

- Accessible learning and learning strategist
 - Programming
 - Referrals
- Faculty members
 - Advocates for instruction and events

ACADEMIC INTEGRITY FACILITATOR



KNOWLEDGE

Faculty and students can get knowledgeable assistance on the Academic Integrity Policy and Procedures from Angela by visiting the Academic Integrity Office.



ASSISTANCE

Faculty can request facilitation for discussions with students regarding potential AI breaches, and Angela can evaluate and assess an AI breach to provide advice on sanctioning.



DATA

Angela will track incidents of academic integrity breaches and use metrics to inform decision-making and AI-related programming.



AWARENESS

Angela will assist in developing an original academic integrity brand for Sheridan, one that embodies the principles associated with AI and provides education and web-based information.



PEER-TO-PEER

Angela will oversee Academic Integrity Student Ambassadors to support peer-to-peer learning between students on academic integrity matters.



RESOURCE

Angela will act as a liaison at the college on academic integrity issues.



ACADEMIC INTEGRITY

REMEDICATION SPECIALISTS

- Offer citation support through drop-in and appointment hours in the Tutoring Centres
- Assist students with creating references for their assignments
- Provide Academic Integrity quiz and tutorial
- Facilitate Academic Integrity Remediation formally (as per a Level-1 sanction at Sheridan) or informally (at a student's request, at a faculty member's encouragement)

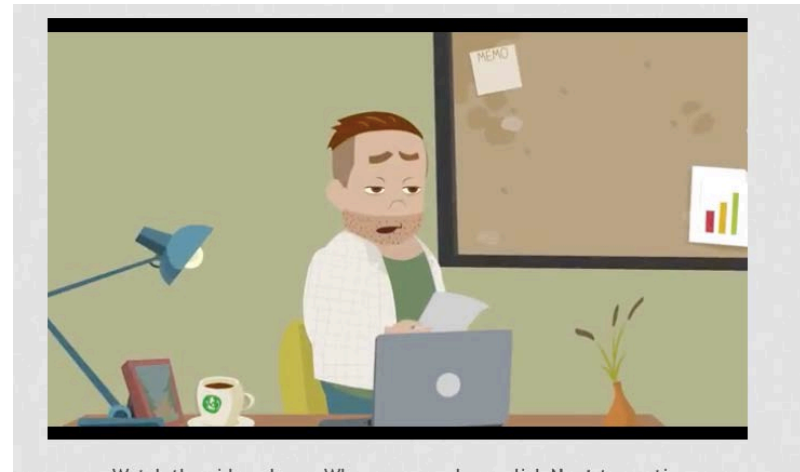
