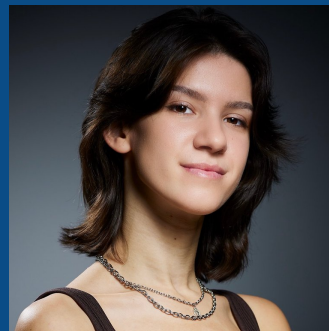

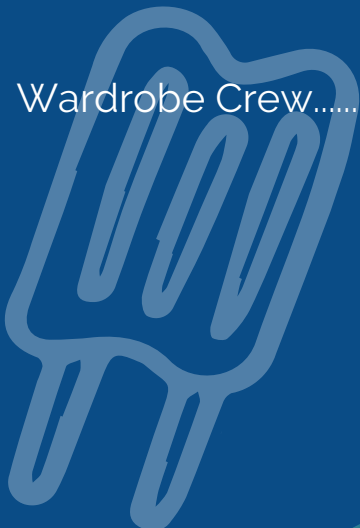

Courtney Ch'ng Lancaster is a theatre maker from Antigonish, Nova Scotia. She is a co-founder and artistic leader of the Toronto-based collective The Howland Company, was most recently the Assistant Artistic Director at Tarragon Theatre in Toronto, and is a former resident artist with Soulpepper Theatre.

Her theatre direction credits include radio play versions of *Three Women of Swatow*, *7 Stories*, *Shape of a Girl* and *Democracy* (Expect Theatre/Tarragon), and live productions of *The Wolves* (Howland/Crows), *Cannibal* (Scrap Paper/Next Stage), *52 Pick-Up* (Howland), *Gray* (Inamorata) and *Three Women of Swatow* (Tarragon). She has performed leading roles with the Shaw Festival, Soulpepper Theatre, Public Recordings, Canadian Stage, Citadel Theatre, Blue Bridge Repertory Theatre, Cahoots Theatre, Native Earth, Tarragon Theatre, and beyond.

Courtney is a graduate of the UBC BFA Theatre program, the Banff Citadel Theatre Program and the Soulpepper Academy. Upcoming work includes the devised piece *The Home Project* in the fall of 2021 (The Howland Company in co-production with Native Earth and Soulpepper), and additional projects at York University and Tarragon Theatre.



Logan Cracknell - Lighting Designer

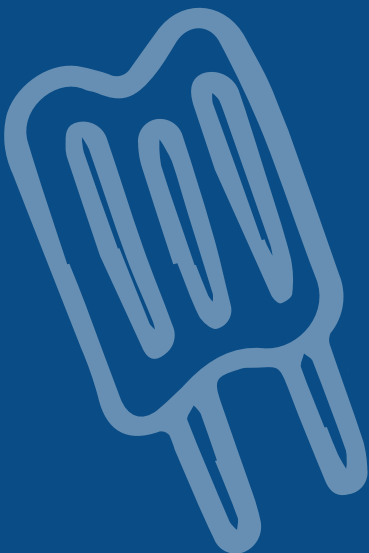

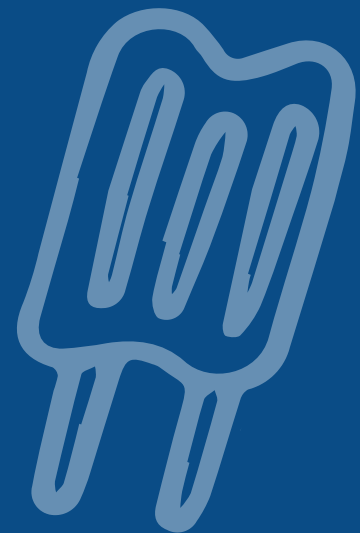
